

**DECLARATION ON *DE MINIMIS* AID**

**Introduction**

Aid from the Nordic Council of Ministers, including the Joint Nordic institutions and other cooperating organisations, is paid in accordance with the guidelines below which correspond to the rules in the *de minimis* regulation.<sup>2</sup> When aid is paid to undertakings the regulation allows payment of state aid provided that the total amount per recipient does not exceed EUR 200,000 over any period of three fiscal years.

Nordic Environment Finance Corporation NEFCO, as fund manager for Nordic Project Fund Nopef, will use the information in this declaration in order to assess how much aid can be given within the scope of the provisions of the *de minimis* regulation.
